

POLICY ON CHANGING ROOMS AND SHOWERING FACILITIES

Clifton Cricket Clubs Changing Policy will be dependent upon the facilities available at the club at any one time, the access to those facilities and the number of children involved.

The following provides a framework of best practice and guidance for Changing Policy developed within the club. These guidelines apply to adults and children sharing changing facilities. We have identified and developed the framework that best suits the changing arrangements, taking into account the number of children involved.

Principles to be adopted are as follows:

1. Adults must not change or shower at the same time using the same facility as Children

2. Adults should try to change at separate times to children during matches i.e. when padding up

3. If Adults and children need to share a changing facility, the Club will obtain consent from the Parents that their child can share a changing room with Adults in the club

4. If children play for Adult Teams, they and their Parents will be informed of the Club's policy on changing arrangements

6. Mobile phones must not be used in changing rooms

Please note that if children are uncomfortable changing or showering at the Club, no pressure will be placed on them to do so and they will be encouraged to do so at home
